<p>The Savage Volunteer Fire Company was established in 1937 and has been providing fire/EMS service to the southern portion of Howard County, MD ever since. We take pride in our diverse group of volunteer members that serve our ever growing community. The mission/purpose of the Savage Volunteer Fire Company is to protect the lives and property of the citizens of our very diverse town and surrounding communities as a team; by responding to the nearly 6,000 emergency medical calls, fires, natural disasters, and hazardous material incidents. We will provide these services and treat those we serve and each other in a professional manner that promotes respect, honesty, fairness, and inclusion.</p>

The Savage Volunteer Fire Company is requesting your assistance in replacing our current 13 year old ambulance which serves the southern Howard County, MD area and surrounding jurisdictions of Prince Georges, Anne Arundel, and Fort Meade/NSA areas. This ambulance has almost 200,000 miles on the unit and is in constant need of repair. We take pride in our very diverse membership providing EMS care to the community. Replacement cost has doubled in the last few years making it nearly impossible for a volunteer organization such as ourselves to fully raise the funds needed. The cost of the project is \$405,000.00 which will have to be raised via donations and fund raising events such as dinners, bingos, and mail drives. Despite our yearly efforts and our contributions from the community we still find ourselves short of the funds needed to make this purchase. Any support would be greatly appreciated and would directly serve the local community.
