AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1654  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 24, after the semicolon insert “prohibiting an edge provider from promoting, impairing, or restricting an end user’s access to lawful Internet content on the basis of the Internet content;”.

On page 2, in line 6, strike “14–4109” and substitute “14–4110”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 21, after “(G)” insert ““EDGE PROVIDER” MEANS A WEBSITE, WEB SERVICE, WEB APPLICATION, ONLINE CONTENT HOSTING SERVICE, OR ONLINE CONTENT DELIVERY SERVICE TO END USERS.

(H) “END USER” MEANS A RECIPIENT OF CONTENT PROVIDED BY AN EDGE PROVIDER.

(I)”;

and in line 24, strike “(H)” and substitute “(J)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 30, strike “A” and substitute “:

(1) A”;

and in line 31, after “STATE” insert “; **AND**

(Over)

**(2) AN EDGE PROVIDER THAT IS ACCESSIBLE ON THE INTERNET TO END USERS IN THE STATE**".

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 9, after line 5, insert:

**"AN EDGE PROVIDER MAY NOT PROMOTE, IMPAIR, OR RESTRICT AN END USER'S ACCESS TO LAWFUL INTERNET CONTENT ON THE BASIS OF THE INTERNET CONTENT.**
