### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in line 42, after "<u>Center</u>" insert "<u>, in collaboration with local law enforcement agencies and local school systems,</u>".

On page 3, in line 2, after the semicolon insert "requiring each local school system to post certain information on the role and authority of school resource officers on the local school system's website; requiring the Governor to appropriate in the annual State budget a certain amount to the Safe Schools Fund to be used to provide certain grants;"; in line 4, after the first "certain" insert "developmentally and"; in line 34, after "safety" insert ", subject to a certain exception"; and in line 35, after "systems" insert "and local law enforcement agencies".

- (II) IF A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM'S JURISDICTION IS NOT ASSIGNED A SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER, THE ADEQUATE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT COVERAGE THAT WILL BE PROVIDED TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL.";

On page 27, after line 2, insert:

- "(F) EACH LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL POST ON THE SCHOOL SYSTEM'S WEBSITE INFORMATION ON THE ROLE AND AUTHORITY OF SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS ASSIGNED TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS WITHIN THE SCHOOL SYSTEM.
- (G) (1) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER,
  THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPROPRIATE IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET
  \$10,000,000 TO THE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING GRANTS TO LOCAL
  SCHOOL SYSTEMS AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO ASSIST IN
  MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION.
- (2) GRANTS PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE MADE TO EACH LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM BASED ON THE NUMBER OF SCHOOLS IN EACH SCHOOL SYSTEM IN PROPORTION TO THE TOTAL NUMBER OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE STATE IN THE PRIOR YEAR.";
