AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 203

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and West” and substitute “West, Benson, Ellis, Guzzone, Kagan, Lam, Nathan–Pulliam, and Patterson”; and in line 4, after the semicolon insert “providing that this Act may not be interpreted to disrupt certain programs”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 22, strike “LAND” and substitute “, AS DETERMINED BY DATA USED IN THE MOST CURRENT CHESAPEAKE BAY WATERSHED MODEL DEFINED IN COMAR 26.08.11.03”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 28, after the comma insert “That this Act may not be interpreted to expand, limit, or otherwise disrupt any program conducted by a unit of State or local government in accordance with to the Chesapeake Bay Total Maximum Daily Load, a municipal separate storm sewer system permit, urban tree canopy goals, or any other local program”.
