AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 793
(First Reading File Bill – Second Printing)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in line 18, before the first “and” insert “submitting certain provisions of this Act to a referendum of the qualified voters of Baltimore City.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 21, after line 3, insert:

“SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That before Sections 2 and 3 of this Act become effective, they first shall be submitted to a referendum of the qualified voters of Baltimore City at the general election to be held in November 2020. The Baltimore City governing body and the Baltimore City Board of Elections shall do those things necessary and proper to provide for and hold the referendum required by this section. If a majority of the votes cast on the question are "For the referred law" Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall become effective on the 30th day following the official canvass of votes for the referendum, but if a majority of the votes cast on the question are "Against the referred law" Sections 2 and 3 of this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be null and void.”;

in line 4, strike “5.” and substitute “6.”; and in the same line, after “That” insert “, subject to Section 5 of this Act.”.
