AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 105  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after “circumstances;” insert “providing for the termination of this Act;”; and strike in their entirety lines 8 through 12, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 14, strike “the Laws of Maryland read as follows:” and substitute “unless, with the approval of the Secretary of Transportation, a unit of the State government assigns the claim to the Central Collection Unit in the Department of Budget and Management, the Central Collection Unit is not responsible for and may not collect any money that is owed for unpaid video tolls and associated civil penalties under § 21-1414 of the Transportation Article under a delinquent account associated with a person residing outside the State.”.

On pages 1 through 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 15 on page 1 through line 9 on page 3, inclusive.

On page 3, in line 11, after the period insert “It shall remain effective for a period of 7 months and, at the end of December 31, 2019, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
