AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 388
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “specifying” in line 5 down through “purposes;” in line 6 and substitute “authorizing a license holder to install a protective covering over an exterior door or window of the licensed premises under certain circumstances; providing that this Act does not prevent an inspection and search of the licensed premises under certain circumstances;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 5, strike “(1)”; strike in their entirety lines 7 through 9, inclusive, and substitute:

“(C) (1) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY INSTALL A PROTECTIVE COVERING OVER AN EXTERIOR DOOR OR WINDOW OF THE LICENSED PREMISES IF THE COVERING IS:

(I) USED ONLY WHEN THE LICENSED PREMISES IS NOT OCCUPIED;

(II) DESIGNED TO PROTECT THE LICENSED PREMISES FROM UNLAWFUL INTRUSION OR DESTRUCTION; AND

(III) SECURED ONLY FROM THE EXTERIOR OF THE LICENSED PREMISES.

(2) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT PREVENT AN INSPECTION AND SEARCH OF THE LICENSED PREMISES UNDER § 6-202 OF THIS ARTICLE.”;
