AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 339  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “requiring” in line 4 down through “parties;” in line 9.

On page 2, strike beginning with “providing” in line 14 down through “Act;” in line 15; in line 15, strike “and” and substitute “a certain term;”; and strike in their entirety lines 17 through 26, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 3 on page 3 through line 6 on page 4, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 17, in line 6, strike “switch” and substitute “**SWITCHED**”.

On page 17 in line 9, and on page 19 in lines 20 and 26, in each instance, strike “TELEPHONE” and substitute “**SWITCHED LOCAL EXCHANGE ACCESS**”.

On page 17 in line 16, and on page 19 in line 31, in each instance, strike “AN EXCHANGE ACCESS FACILITY” and substitute “**A 9-1-1 ACCESSIBLE SERVICE**”.

On page 17 in line 18, and on page 19 in line 33, in each instance, strike “TELEPHONE” and substitute “**9-1-1 ACCESSIBLE**”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 17, in line 8, strike “(4)” and substitute “(5)”; in line 13, strike “AND (4)” and substitute “**THROUGH (5)**”; after line 19, insert:

(Over)

**“(3) CMRS PROVIDED TO MULTIPLE DEVICES THAT SHARE A MOBILE TELEPHONE NUMBER SHALL BE TREATED AS A SINGLE 9-1-1 ACCESSIBLE SERVICE FOR PURPOSES OF CALCULATING THE 9-1-1 FEE DUE UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.”;**

and in lines 20 and 23, strike “(3)” and “(4)”, respectively, and substitute “(4)” and “(5)”, respectively.

On page 19, in line 18, strike “(5)” and substitute “(6)”; in line 28, strike “AND (5)” and substitute “THROUGH (6)”; and after line 35, insert:

**“(4) CMRS PROVIDED TO MULTIPLE DEVICES THAT SHARE A MOBILE TELEPHONE NUMBER SHALL BE TREATED AS A SINGLE 9-1-1 ACCESSIBLE SERVICE FOR PURPOSES OF CALCULATING THE ADDITIONAL CHARGES DUE UNDER PARAGRAPHS (1) AND (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.”.**

On page 20, in lines 1, 5, and 20, strike “(4)”, “(5)”, and “(6)”, respectively, and substitute “(5)”, “(6)”, and “(7)”, respectively.
