A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Naming of State Properties and Public Improvements**

3 FOR the purpose of codifying the current practice under which the designation of a  
4 commemorative or honorific name for a public improvement that is owned by the  
5 State and used for State purposes must be enacted by the General Assembly by law  
6 or be approved by the Board of Public Works.

7 BY adding to

8 Article - State Finance and Procurement  
9 Section 10-206  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

15 10-206.

16 EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW, A PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT THAT IS  
17 OWNED BY THE STATE AND USED FOR STATE PURPOSES MAY NOT BE DESIGNATED  
18 BY A COMMEMORATIVE OR HONORIFIC NAME UNLESS THE DESIGNATION IS  
19 APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 October 1, 1996.
