13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES, THE DEPARTMENT OF
18 TRANSPORTATION, AND THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SYSTEM SHALL RESERVE
