11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 (a) The Maryland Public Broadcasting Commission consists of 11 members
16 appointed by the Governor WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 1996.
