House Bill 690 (Prince George's County and Montgomery County Delegations)
Commerce and Government Matters

**Montgomery and Prince George's Counties - District of Columbia Water and Sewer
Authority - Appointment of Board Members**
PG/MC 50-96

This bill authorizes the Montgomery County and Prince George's County legislative delegations to designate one person each to serve as a member of the Board of Directors of the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority. This authority would own and operate the Blue Plains sewage treatment plant.

The bill is contingent on the passage of Bill 11-102 of the Acts of the District of Columbia of 1995, which transfers the plant from the District to the authority. The Chairman of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission must notify the Department of Legislative Reference when this legislation takes effect.

The bill is effective July 1, 1996.

Fiscal Summary

Local Effect: None. Authorizing Montgomery and Prince George's counties to appoint one board member each would not directly affect governmental finances.
