House Bill 1290 (Harford County Delegation)

Economic Matters

Referred to Economic and Environmental Affairs

Alcoholic Beverages - Harford County
(Off-Premises Pub-Brewery License Sales)

This amended bill adds Harford County to those jurisdictions in which the holder of a Class 6 pub-brewery license may sell malt beverages for off-premises consumption in sealed refillable containers. A holder of a pub-brewery license may not sell malt beverages to any retail alcoholic beverages licensee in the State for the purpose of a subsequent sale or distribution of the malt beverage under the retail license.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Expanding the authority of a licensee in Harford County to sell malt beverages off-premises would not directly affect county finances.
