Referred to Economic and Environmental Affairs

Baltimore County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Procedure - Notice of Charges)

This enrolled bill provides that in Baltimore County a notice of charges of complaint against an alcoholic beverages licensee must be given by personal service to the licensee or an adult employee of the licensee or by any other method in conformity with the service of process under Maryland Rules 2-121 and 2-122. If service of notice is given to an adult employee, a copy of the notice must be mailed to the licensee within 72 hours of the day service is given to the adult employee.
