**Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages**  
**(Billiard Hall Exemption)**  
**MC 602-96**

This bill allows billiard halls in Montgomery County to obtain Class B (on-sale) beer or beer and light wine alcoholic beverages licenses.

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Montgomery County revenues would increase by \$400 annually, excluding application fees, for each Class B license issued to billiard halls. This estimate reflects only the annual license fee. Although the potential number of licenses to be issued cannot be determined beforehand, the revenue increase would be minimal. The Board of License Commissioners could issue the licenses and monitor licensees with existing resources.
