House Bill 563 (Delegate Arnick, et al.)
Commerce and Government Matters

AELR Committee - Delay of Regulations

This bill authorizes the Administrative, Executive, and Legislative Review Committee, with a three-fourths vote, to delay the implementation of a regulation for 30 days if the committee determines that a unit has exceeded its statutory authority or misinterpreted legislative intent. The bill also authorizes the committee to hold a public meeting with the head of the unit requesting such regulations.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Indeterminate effect on revenues and expenditures, as discussed below.

Local Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

State Revenues: Revenues would be affected to the extent that proposed regulations increasing or decreasing revenues are delayed pursuant to this bill. Any such effect cannot be estimated at this time, although it could be significant.

State Expenditures: Expenditures would be affected to the extent that proposed regulations increasing or decreasing expenditures are delayed pursuant to this bill. Any such effect cannot be estimated at this time, although it could be significant.

Printing costs incurred by the Division of State Documents for the Maryland Register could increase by a minimal amount because additional hearing notices would be required for regulations that are delayed pursuant to the bill.
