FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 1327 (Cecil County Delegation)
Economic Matters

Cecil County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Caterer's License)

This bill creates a caterer's alcoholic beverages license in Cecil County. The maximum number of days that the Board of License Commissioners may authorize is 12 per year. The annual license fee must be set by the board after the approval of the county commissioners. Before the board approves an application, it must publish a one-time notice in one newspaper of general circulation in the county.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Cecil County revenues could increase depending upon the number of caterer's licenses issued and the license fees imposed by the Board of License Commissioners. At this time, the increase cannot be determined, but it is assumed to be minimal. In addition, the board could issue the licenses and monitor licensees with existing resources.
