House Bill 1289 (Harford County Delegation)

Harford County - Sheriff - Salary

---

This amended bill increases from \$60,000 to \$70,000 the salary of the Harford County Sheriff beginning December 1, 1998 and thereafter. The bill's provisions do not apply to the salary of the incumbent Sheriff.

---

Fiscal Summary

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Harford County expenditures would increase by \$5,833 in FY 1999 and \$10,000 annually thereafter, excluding fringe benefits. Revenues would not be affected.

---

Fiscal Analysis

**Local Expenditures:** Currently, the Harford County Sheriff receives a salary of \$60,000, plus fringe benefits. Beginning with the next term of office, the salary would increase to \$70,000. Accordingly, county expenditures would increase by \$5,833 in fiscal 1999, excluding fringe benefits. This estimate reflects the increase in salary for seven months. Beginning in fiscal 2000, county expenditures would increase by \$10,000 annually, excluding fringe benefits.
