Economic and Environmental Affairs Referred to Ways and Means

Education - Parent Surrogates

This amended departmental bill requires local school superintendents, instead of the State superintendent, to appoint parent surrogates for disabled children who are wards of the State or whose parents are unknown or unavailable.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1996.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Since local boards of education already suggest names of parent surrogates to the State superintendent, local finances would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: The Department of Education has determined that this bill has minimal or no impact on small business (attached). Fiscal Services concurs with this assessment. (The attached assessment does not reflect amendments to the bill.)
