AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 366  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in lines 4 and 5, strike “educational requirements of” and substitute “academic credits required for”; in line 6, after “renewed;” insert “reducing the amount of time an apprentice must work and the number of embalmings and funerals an apprentice must assist with or participate in;”; in line 7, strike “number of years” and substitute “amount of time”; and in line 17, strike “7-306(c)” and substitute “7-306(c) and (d)(3)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike beginning with the first “not” in line 27 down through “terms” in line 28 and substitute “A 1-YEAR LICENSED APPRENTICESHIP”.

On page 2, in line 24, after “HAVE” insert “:

(I)”;

in line 25, strike “EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS” and substitute “ACADEMIC CREDITS REQUIRED”; and in line 27, after “BOARD” insert “; AND

(II) A GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF 2.0 OR HIGHER”;

after line 29, insert:

“(d) (3) The practical experience of an apprentice shall include:

(i) Participation in at least [25] 20 funerals;

(Over)

(ii) Assistance in the embalming of at least [25] 20 dead human bodies; and  
(iii) Completion of [2,000] 1,000 working hours in a licensed funeral  
establishment under the direct supervision of a licensed mortician. Supervision may include  
instruction by other licensed morticians employed or supervised by the sponsor.”;

in line 37, strike “TWO times” and substitute “ONE TIME”; and strike beginning with “unless” in line 37 down through “terms” in line 38.
