3 FOR the purpose of altering the amount of a contract for which the County

4 Commissioners of Washington County or any employee of the county is required to

5 advertise for bids.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 22 - Washington County**

15 1-106.

16 (a) The County Commissioners or any employee of the county may not enter into

17 any contract of sale or purchase or any contract for any county work, project, or other

18 expenditure to which the county is a party where the amount involved in the contract

19 exceeds [\$15,000] \$25,000 without advertising for bids at least 1 week before the bid by

20 publication in at least one newspaper that is published in the county or through electronic

21 media.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

23 October 1, 1997.
