A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Academic Facilities Bonding Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of approving certain projects for the acquisition, development, and
4 improvement of certain academic facilities for the University of Maryland System;
5 and approving the issuance of bonds by the University of Maryland System for
6 financing the projects.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
8 MARYLAND, That:

9 (1) In accordance with Title 19 of the Education Article, each of the following
10 projects is approved as a project for an academic facility, and the University of Maryland
11 System may issue, sell, and deliver bonds in the total principal amount of \$18,096,000 for
12 the purposes of financing and refinancing the costs of these projects:

13 (A) University of Maryland College Park (Prince George's County)

14 (1) Steam Plant Improvements

15 (2) Capital Equipment: Maryland Center for the Performing Arts

16 (3) Capital Equipment: Technology Advancement Program Facility

17 (B) Towson State University (Baltimore County)

19 (C) University of Maryland Biotechnology Institute (Baltimore City)

20 (1) Capital Equipment: Medical Biotechnology Center

21 (2) In accordance with Title 19 of the Education Article, each of the following
22 capital facilities renewal projects (statewide) is hereby approved as a project for an
23 academic facility, and the University of Maryland System may issue, sell, and deliver
24 bonds in the principal amount of \$11,904,000 for the purposes of financing and
25 refinancing the costs of these projects:

13 (3) The bonds issued under the authority of this Act do not create or constitute
14 any indebtedness or obligation of the State or of any political subdivision thereof except
15 the University of Maryland System, and the bonds shall so state on their face. The bonds
16 do not constitute a debt or obligation contracted by the General Assembly of Maryland or
17 pledge the faith and credit of the State within the meaning of Article III, Section 34 of the
18 Constitution of Maryland.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 June 1, 1997.
