A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Aviation Administration - Airport Personnel - Identification Badges**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Aviation Administrator to take certain actions to  
4 require that each officer and employee of the State Aviation Administration and  
5 every other person who provides certain goods or services at an airport property  
6 subject to the jurisdiction of the Administration wear at all times while the  
7 individual is on the premises of certain airport property an official identification  
8 badge that contains a photograph of the individual; and generally relating to the  
9 requirement that certain individuals who are subject to the jurisdiction of the State  
10 Aviation Administration wear a photographic identification badge at all times while  
11 on the premises of airport property that is subject to the Administration's  
12 jurisdiction.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article - Transportation**

21 5-214.

22 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:

23 (1) EACH OFFICER OF THE ADMINISTRATION;

24 (2) EACH EMPLOYEE OF THE ADMINISTRATION; AND

25 (3) ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL SUBJECT TO, OR AFFILIATED WITH A  
26 PERSON SUBJECT TO, A CONTRACT, LEASE, OR OTHER ARRANGEMENT TO PROVIDE  
27 GOODS OR SERVICES AT AN AIRPORT, AIRPORT FACILITY, OR AIR NAVIGATION  
28 FACILITY OWNED OR CONTROLLED BY THE STATE OR A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF  
29 THE STATE.

1 (B) (1) THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL PERFORM ANY ACT, ISSUE AND  
2 AMEND ANY ORDER, ADOPT AND AMEND ANY GENERAL OR SPECIAL RULE,  
3 REGULATION, OR PROCEDURE, OR ESTABLISH ANY STANDARD THAT THE  
4 ADMINISTRATOR CONSIDERS NECESSARY TO REQUIRE THAT EACH INDIVIDUAL  
5 SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION WEAR AT ALL TIMES WHILE THE INDIVIDUAL IS ON THE  
6 PREMISES OF ANY PROPERTY SUBJECT TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE  
7 ADMINISTRATION AN OFFICIAL IDENTIFICATION BADGE ISSUED BY THE  
8 ADMINISTRATION THAT CONTAINS THE INDIVIDUAL'S PHOTOGRAPH .

9 (2) ANY ACTION, ORDER, RULE, REGULATION, OR PROCEDURE  
10 IMPLEMENTED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE  
11 CONSISTENT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS AND DUTIES VESTED IN THE  
12 ADMINISTRATOR UNDER THIS TITLE AND WITH THE REQUIREMENTS AND  
13 LIMITATIONS OF ANY OTHER PROVISION OF STATE OR FEDERAL LAW.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
15 October 1, 1997.
