19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

2 7-101.

3 (g) The special licenses provided for in this section may not be issued in any
4 county or in Baltimore City, or in this State in case of application for statewide license, if
5 the issuance of a regular license of the same class is not authorized by this article.

6 (o) (1) This subsection applies only in Frederick County.

7 (2) (I) This [subsection] PARAGRAPH:

8 [(i)] 1. Permits sales for off-premises consumption only on the days
9 permitted by the license for the special anniversary or special event; and

10 [(ii)] 2. Applies only to special anniversary or special event
11 collectible bottles.

12 [(3)] (II) After obtaining a license pursuant to this section, the following
13 licensees may sell collectible bottles of wine or liquor:

14 [(i)] 1. Special Class C beer and light wine; and

15 [(ii)] 2. Special Class C beer, wine and liquor.

16 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED BY THIS
17 ARTICLE, SPECIAL LICENSES MAY BE ISSUED FOR THE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES
18 DESCRIBED IN § 8-211(G) OF THIS ARTICLE.

20 (a) The provisions of this section apply only in Frederick County.

21 (b) A license for the sale of alcoholic beverages authorized by this article may not
22 be issued for any place of business located in any of the following election districts:

23 Catoclin (6th),

24 Hauvers (10th),

25 Jackson (16th),

26 Liganore (19th),

27 Tuscarora (21st), and

28 Ballenger (23rd).

29 (c) Class A, B, and C licenses for the sale of beer only, as authorized by this
30 article, shall be issued for places of business located in any of the following election
31 districts:

32 Middletown (3rd),

33 Jefferson (14th),

34 Johnsville (17th), and

1 Burkittsville (22nd).

2 (d) Class A, B, and C licenses for the sale of beer and light wine and A, B, and C
3 licenses for the sale of beer, wine and liquor, as authorized by this article, shall be issued
4 for places of business located in any of the following election districts:

5 Buckeystown (1st),

6 Frederick (2nd),

7 Creagerstown (4th),

8 Emmitsburg (5th),

9 Urbana (7th),

10 Liberty (8th),

11 New Market (9th),

12 Woodsboro (11th),

13 Petersville (12th),

14 Mt. Pleasant (13th),

15 Thurmont (15th),

16 Woodville (18th),

17 Lewistown (20th),

18 Braddock (24th),

19 Brunswick (25th), and

20 Walkersville (26th).

21 (e) Class C licenses for the sale of beer, wine and liquor, as authorized by this
22 article, shall be issued for places of business located in the 3rd election district.

23 (f) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section wine may be sold as
24 provided under a winery license, a limited winery license, or a Class A light wine license
25 in any election district.

26 (G) (1) THE RESTRICTIONS IN THIS SECTION AND IN § 7-101(G) OF THIS
27 ARTICLE DO NOT APPLY TO LICENSES ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION.

28 (2) THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES MAY OBTAIN A LICENSE FOR THE SALE
29 OF BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR:

30 (I) MIDDLETOWN VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY;

31 (II) WOLFVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY;

32 (III) JEFFERSON VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY; AND

1 (IV) MYERSVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY;~~AND~~

2 ~~(V) 4 H CAMP CENTER.~~

3 (3) ALL NET PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
4 FOR THE ENTITIES LISTED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED
5 SOLELY ~~FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:~~

6 ~~(I) IF A FIRE COMPANY, TO PURCHASE FIRE AND RESCUE~~
7 ~~EQUIPMENT, AND FOR OPERATING EXPENSES, AND FOR CONSTRUCTING AND~~
8 ~~MAINTAINING THE BUILDINGS WHICH HOUSE THE EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT; OR~~

9 ~~(II) IF ANOTHER ENTITY, TO CONSTRUCT, RENOVATE, AND~~
10 ~~MODERNIZE THE STRUCTURES, AND TO SUBSIDIZE THE WORK OF THE~~
11 ~~ORGANIZATION.~~

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 1997.
