Vehicle Laws - Pedestrian Control Signal Indications

This departmental bill includes the use of symbols as pedestrian control signal indications in current provisions. The bill specifies that the symbol of a walking person may be used in place of the word “walk” and the symbol of an upraised hand may be used in place of the words “wait” or “don’t walk”.
