**Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages (Board of License Commissioners -  
Employees)**

---

This bill requires that employees of the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners be in the classified civil service of Baltimore City. Accordingly, the board may appoint and remove employees only in accordance with the laws governing civil service employees. The bill also provides that the board may not employ more than 18 permanent part-time inspectors.

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Adding the board's employees to the classified civil service of Baltimore City could affect future labor costs for such employees. The magnitude and direction of any impact on personnel costs cannot be reliably estimated at this time, but is assumed to be minimal.

**Small Business Effect:** None. The bill would not directly affect small businesses.
