**Garrett County - Property Taxes - Procedures**

---

This bill repeals provisions in the Public Local Laws of Garrett County relating to property taxes, including procedures for the collection of delinquent taxes, sale of property, and disposition of property after a tax sale. The bill requires the county commissioners to set by resolution the date and time of a tax sale. The county must publish a notice that delinquent property will be sold at public auction three times, once a week for three successive weeks.

The bill is effective July 1, 1997.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Garrett County expenditures could decrease by a minimal amount due to fewer public notice advertisements. No effect on revenues.

**Small Business Effect:** None. The bill would not directly affect small businesses.
