## Same Sex Marriages - Foreign Jurisdictions - Invalidity

This bill provides that a same sex marriage entered into in another state or in a foreign country is not valid in Maryland. Such marriages are against the public policy of this State. In addition, the bill adds to the current law definition of "foreign marriage" by specifying that it means a marriage ceremony between a woman and a man.
