Senate Bill 868 (Senator Astle)
Economic and Environmental Affairs

Education - Public Schools - Hearing Examiners for Proceedings Involving Students

This bill enables a county board of education to select a hearing examiner to preside over appeal proceedings involving student suspension or expulsion cases. Under current law, such cases are heard by the county board or its designated committee.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1997.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Enabling a hearing examiner to hear appeals of student suspension or expulsion cases would not affect local finances.

Small Business Effect: None. Small businesses are not directly affected.
