AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 302

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after "Commissioners;" insert "authorizing certain personnel to be part of the classified civil service of Baltimore City; establishing the position of Administrative Coordinator, which shall be part of the classified civil service of Baltimore City; requiring the Board of License Commissioners to determine the salaries of certain employees;"; and in line 20, after "15-112(d)(10)" insert "and (11)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 30, insert:

"(V) THE INSPECTOR SUPERVISOR, ASSISTANT INSPECTOR SUPERVISOR, OFFICE ASSISTANT, ACCOUNTING ASSISTANT, SECRETARY III, OFFICE SUPERVISOR, AND APPLICATIONS INVESTIGATOR APPOINTED PRIOR TO OCTOBER 1, 1998 SHALL CONTINUE THEIR APPOINTMENT AFTER THAT DATE UNLESS REMOVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE PROCEDURES.

(VI) AS OF OCTOBER 1, 1998:

1. THE INSPECTOR SUPERVISOR, ASSISTANT INSPECTOR SUPERVISOR, OFFICE ASSISTANT, ACCOUNTING ASSISTANT, SECRETARY III, AND OFFICE SUPERVISOR ARE PART OF THE CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE OF BALTIMORE CITY.

2. THERE SHALL BE AN ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR WHICH POSITION SHALL REPLACE THE POSITION OF APPLICATIONS INVESTIGATOR. THE ADMINISTRATIVE COORDINATOR SHALL BE PART OF THE CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE OF BALTIMORE CITY.

(Over)

(10) (I) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE SALARIES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATORS FROM BALTIMORE CITY.

(II) THE BOARD MAY CONSIDER AN EMPLOYEE'S LENGTH OF SERVICE IN DETERMINING THE APPROPRIATE SALARY LEVEL."

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 31, strike "(10)" and substitute "(11)".
