2 **Calvert County Board of Education - Authority to Appoint the County**
3 **Superintendent of Schools**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Calvert County Board of Education to appoint the
5 Calvert County Superintendent of Schools to a term of a certain length; and
6 generally relating to the authority of the Calvert County Board of Education.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Education**

15 4-201.

16 (b) (1) (I) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS
17 PARAGRAPH, THE term of a county superintendent is 4 years beginning on July 1.

18 (II) IN CALVERT COUNTY, THE COUNTY BOARD MAY APPOINT A
19 COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT TO EITHER A 2-YEAR OR A 4-YEAR TERM, BEGINNING ON
20 JULY 1.

21 (III) A county superintendent continues to serve until a successor is
22 appointed and qualifies.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
24 July 1, 1998.
