A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Alcoholic Beverages - Anne Arundel County - Special Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of exempting 1-day special alcoholic beverages licenses in Anne  
4 Arundel County from certain application, notice, and hearing requirements.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
6 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
7 Section 7-101(a)  
8 Annotated Code of Maryland  
9 (1996 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

13 7-101.

14 (a) (1) On approval by the board of license commissioners for that  
15 jurisdiction, if any, of a proper application, made on forms prescribed by the State  
16 Comptroller, signed and sworn to, the license issuing authority may grant the types of  
17 special licenses for the periods and at the fees specified in this section.

18 (2) For an application for a statewide license, the Comptroller may grant  
19 the license.

20 (3) IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, THE PROVISIONS OF §§ 10-103 AND  
21 10-202 OF THIS ARTICLE AND § 10-501 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE DO NOT  
22 APPLY TO AN APPLICANT FOR A SPECIAL LICENSE THAT IS NOT TO EXCEED 1 DAY.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
24 October 1, 1998.
