CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Military Department - Assistant Adjutant General for Army and Air**

3 FOR the purpose of allowing the Assistant Adjutant General for Army and the
4 Assistant Adjutant General for Air to have a commissioned grade above that of
5 Brigadier General under certain circumstances; making technical changes; and
6 generally relating to the State Military Department.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
8 Article 65 - Militia
9 Section 9(b) and (c)
10 Annotated Code of Maryland
11 (1995 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 65 - Militia**

15 9.

16 (b) An Assistant Adjutant General for Army shall:

17 (1) [be] BE appointed by the Governor and [his term of office shall be]
18 SERVE at the pleasure of the Governor[.];

1 (2) [He shall have] HAVE a commissioned grade not above that of
2 brigadier general, ~~UNLESS SELECTED AS COMMANDER OF THE 29TH INFANTRY~~
3 ~~DIVISION (LIGHT) AND FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED~~ FOR A MILITARY POSITION
4 REQUIRING FEDERAL RECOGNITION AS A MAJOR GENERAL;

5 (3) [and his salary shall be] HAVE A SALARY as stated in the annual
6 budget[.]; AND

7 (4) [He will perform] PERFORM such military duties as may be assigned
8 [to him] by the Governor or by the Adjutant General.

9 (c) An Assistant Adjutant General for Air shall:

10 (1) [be] BE appointed by the Governor and [his term of office shall be]
11 SERVE at the pleasure of the Governor[.];

12 (2) [He shall have] HAVE a commissioned grade not above that of
13 Brigadier General, UNLESS SELECTED FOR A MILITARY POSITION REQUIRING
14 FEDERAL RECOGNITION AS A MAJOR GENERAL; AND

15 (3) [He will perform] PERFORM such military duties as may be assigned
16 [to him] by the Governor or by the Adjutant General.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
18 effect October 1, 1998.
