FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 1181 (Carroll County Delegation)

Judiciary

Carroll County - Sheriff's Salary

This bill increases the salary of the Carroll County Sheriff, beginning with the next term of office, from \$37,500 to \$45,000.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Minimal expenditure increase. No effect on revenues.

Local Effect: Carroll County expenditures would increase by \$5,731 in FY 1999, and \$9,825 annually thereafter.

Small Business Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

State Expenditures: The State is responsible for making the retirement contributions for the Carroll County Sheriff. Based on the State's fiscal 1999 contribution rate of 7.13% of salary, expenditures would increase by \$312 in fiscal 1999 for seven months. Future increases would depend upon the contribution rate in effect for any given year.

Local Effect: Under existing law, the Carroll County Sheriff's salary is \$37,500 annually. Expenditures would increase by \$5,731 in fiscal 1999, which reflects the salary increase for seven months and associated fringe benefits. Beginning in fiscal 2000, annual expenditures would increase by \$9,825.
