House Bill 653 (Prince George's County Delegation)

Economic Matters

Prince George's County - Peddlers and Transient Vendors - State Highways
PG 415-98

This emergency bill prohibits transient vendors or holders of a peddler license from conducting business on a State highway in Prince George's County.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Enforcement of this bill on State highways could be handled within the existing budgeted resources of the State police.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal (see below).

Fiscal Analysis

Small Business Effect: Any transient vendor or peddler licensee operating as a small business would have the option of relocating operations to a roadway that is not a State highway or to a county without such a restriction. While the extent to which this bill would affect the sales and profits of a particular vendor or peddler is uncertain, it is assumed that the net effect on such enterprises countywide would be minimal.
