House Bill 1189 (Washington County Delegation)

Economic Matters

Washington County - Alcoholic Beverages - Administrative Proceedings

This bill for Washington County authorizes the board of license commissioners to proceed administratively against a licensee if the licensee or employee of the licensee was granted probation before judgment for a violation of alcoholic beverage laws regarding the selling of alcoholic beverages to a minor or to an intoxicated person. Current law provides that if a licensee or employee of a licensee is placed on probation without a verdict for these violations, the board of license commissioners may not bring any administrative proceedings.

Fiscal Summary

Local Effect: Any fines or suspensions imposed pursuant to this bill would be minimal. No effect on expenditures.
