AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1060

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "Exposure" in line 2 down through "Tobacco" in line 3 and substitute "Occupational Exposure"; strike beginning with "in" in line 6 down through "smoke" in line 7 and substitute "based on a certain exposure to a substance that occurred"; and in line 7, after "date;" insert "defining a certain term; making stylistic changes;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 18, after "(a)" insert "(1)"; in the same line, strike the colon and substitute "THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED."; in lines 19, 20, 23, and 27, strike "(1)", "(i)", "(ii)", and "(2)", respectively, and substitute "(2) (I)", "1.", "2.", and "(II)", respectively; and in line 26, strike "; and" and substitute a period.

On page 2, in line 1, after "(3)" insert "“OCCUPATIONAL EXPOSURE” MEANS EXPOSURE TO A SUBSTANCE IN A PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT THAT IS A CAUSE OF DISEASE IN:

(I) A PERSON EXPOSED TO THE SUBSTANCE IN THE PERSON'S EMPLOYMENT; OR

(II) THE SPOUSE OR OTHER FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD MEMBER OF THE PERSON.

(4);

in line 3, strike "(4)" and substitute "(5)"; in line 6, strike "IN WHICH A PERSON WAS EXPOSED" and substitute "THAT IS BASED ON AN OCCUPATIONAL EXPOSURE THAT OCCURRED"; and strike beginning with the second comma in line 7 down through "PERSON" in line 11.
