## Chapter 741 of the Acts of 1997

- 2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 3 June 1, 1997. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and [1 month] 7
- 4 MONTHS and, at the end of [June 30] DECEMBER 31, 1999, with no further action
- 5 required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force 6 and effect.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 June 1, 1999 is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of
