- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that the term of licensure for an assisted living
- 4 program is 2 years; and generally relating to licenses for assisted living

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Health General
- 14 19-323.
- 15 (a) (1) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) OF THIS
- 16 SUBSECTION, A license for a related institution[, except for a nursing facility, or a
- 17 nonaccredited hospital] expires on the first anniversary of its effective date, unless
- 18 the license is renewed for a 1-year term as provided in this section.
- 19 (2) A license for an accredited hospital expires when the certificate of
- 20 accreditation expires.
- 21 (3) A license for a nursing facility AND AN ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM
- 22 AS DEFINED UNDER SUBTITLE 18 OF THIS TITLE shall be for a 2-year term.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 24 effect October 1, 1999.
