SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## **HOUSE BILL 165**

Article - Environment

- 2 9-233.
- 3 The Department may not issue a permit to install, materially alter, or
- 4 materially extend a sewage sludge composting facility OR A SEWAGE SLUDGE
- 5 STORAGE FACILITY until:
- 6 (1) The sewage sludge composting facility OR SEWAGE SLUDGE STORAGE
- 7 FACILITY meets all zoning and land use requirements of the county where the sewage
- 8 sludge composting OR STORAGE facility is to be located; and
- 9 (2) [The] IN THE CASE OF A SEWAGE SLUDGE COMPOSTING FACILITY,
- 10 THE Department has a written statement that the board of county commissioners or
- 11 the county council of the county where the sewage sludge composting facility is to be
- 12 located does not oppose the issuance of the permit.
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 14 October July 1, 1999.
