## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 St. Mary's County Metropolitan Commission - Purpose, Intent, and Function

- 3 FOR the purpose of clarifying the purpose, intent, and function of the St. Mary's
- 4 County Metropolitan Commission; designating the Commission, at its option, as
- 5 the exclusive provider of water and sewer services within St. Mary's County,
- 6 subject to a certain exception; making stylistic and technical changes; and
- 7 generally relating to the purpose, intent, and function of the St. Mary's County
- 8 Metropolitan Commission.
- 9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 10 The Public Local Laws of St. Mary's County
- 11 Section 113-1 A.
- 12 Article 19 Public Local Laws of Maryland
- 13 (1978 Edition and November 1998 Supplement, as amended)
- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article 19 - St. Mary's County

- 18 A. IT IS THE INTENT OF THIS CHAPTER TO ESTABLISH THE ST. MARY'S
- 19 COUNTY METROPOLITAN COMMISSION. THE FUNCTION OF THE COMMISSION IS TO
- 20 PROVIDE WATER AND SEWER SERVICE TO CITIZENS OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY. TO THAT
- 21 END, THE COMMISSION IS HEREBY DESIGNATED TO BE, AT ITS OPTION, THE
- 22 EXCLUSIVE PROVIDER OF WATER AND SEWER SERVICES WITHIN ST. MARY'S COUNTY
- 23 EXCEPT WHERE SUCH SERVICES ARE INTENDED FOR PRIVATE PROPERTIES UNDER A
- 24 SINGLE OWNERSHIP. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this chapter,
- 25 the sanitary districts created are under the jurisdiction of the Commission of seven
- 26 [(7)] persons. Each member of the Commission shall be appointed by the Board of
- 27 County Commissioners of St. Mary's County as follows: one [(1)] member from each
- 28 of the first, third, sixth, seventh and eighth districts, one [(1)] member from the
- 29 second and ninth election districts and one [(1)] member from the fourth and fifth
- 30 election districts. Each member shall reside in the election district [he] THE MEMBER

- 1 represents, be a resident taxpayer of the county and be a qualified voter. The
- 2 members of the Commission shall be appointed for a three-year term and shall serve
- 3 until their successors are appointed and have qualified. [Those persons serving as
- 4 members of the Commission immediately prior to June 1, 1976, shall continue to
- 5 serve in their respective positions until the expiration of their terms.] As the term of
- 6 each [Commissioner] MEMBER expires, [his] A successor shall be appointed by the
- 7 Board of County Commissioner of St. Mary's County. Any vacancy in the membership
- 8 of the Commission shall be filled by appointment by the Board of County
- 9 Commissioners of St. Mary's County for the unexpired term.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 October 1, 1999.
