14 15 N	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 H 21 H 22 H	A. IT IS THE INTENT OF THIS CHAPTER TO ESTABLISH THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY METROPOLITAN COMMISSION. THE FUNCTION OF THE COMMISSION IS TO PROVIDE WATER AND SEWER SERVICE TO CITIZENS OF ST. MARY'S COUNTY. TO THAT END, THE COMMISSION IS HEREBY DESIGNATED TO BE, AT ITS OPTION, THE EXCLUSIVE PROVIDER OF WATER AND SEWER SERVICES WITHIN ST. MARY'S COUNTY EXCEPT WHERE SUCH SERVICES ARE: (1) INTENDED FOR PRIVATE PROPERTIES

- 1 UNDER A SINGLE OWNERSHIP, (2) PROVIDED THROUGH FACILITIES OWNED BY THE
- 2 STATE OR AN INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE STATE, OR (3) PROVIDED THROUGH
- 3 FACILITIES OWNED BY A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION. For the purpose of carrying out
- 4 the provisions of this chapter, the sanitary districts created are under the jurisdiction
- 5 of the Commission of seven [(7)] persons. Each member of the Commission shall be
- 6 appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County as follows: one
- 7 [(1)] member from each of the first, third, sixth, seventh and eighth districts, one
- 8 [(1)] member from the second and ninth election districts and one [(1)] member from
- 9 the fourth and fifth election districts. Each member shall reside in the election
- 10 district [he] THE MEMBER represents, be a resident taxpayer of the county and be a
- 11 qualified voter. The members of the Commission shall be appointed for a three-year
- 12 term and shall serve until their successors are appointed and have qualified. [Those
- 13 persons serving as members of the Commission immediately prior to June 1, 1976,
- 14 shall continue to serve in their respective positions until the expiration of their
- 15 terms.] As the term of each [Commissioner] MEMBER expires, [his] A successor
- 16 shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioner of St. Mary's County. Any
- 17 vacancy in the membership of the Commission shall be filled by appointment by the
- 18 Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County for the unexpired term.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 1999.
