13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Whoever wilfully and maliciously administers [poison] A POISONOUS

17 SUBSTANCE or ground glass to any dog or exposes any poisonous substance or ground

18 glass, on his own lands or the lands of another, with intent that the [said] poisonous

19 substance or ground glass be taken or swallowed by a dog shall be guilty of a

20 misdemeanor, and upon conviction [thereof shall be fined for each offense, not more

21 than one hundred dollars (\$100.00)] SHALL BE SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT

22 MORE THAN 60 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR BOTH.
