4 FOR the purpose of requiring a candidate for the office of the chief executive officer of

- 5 a political subdivision to be a resident of the political subdivision for a certain
- 6 period of time under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; providing for
- 7 the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to residency requirements
- 8 for chief executive officers of political subdivisions.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS
5 PRECEDING THE GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER.

6 (C) IF THE CHARTER OF A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION CONTAINS A DURATIONAL
7 RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT THAT IS LONGER THAN 6 MONTHS, THE LONGER
8 DURATIONAL RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT SHALL BE RETAINED IF THE GOVERNING
9 BODY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION REAFFIRMS THE LONGER DURATIONAL
10 RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT BY ENACTMENT OF AN ORDINANCE EFFECTIVE NO
11 LATER THAN 4 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE FILING DEADLINE SPECIFIED IN ARTICLE 33, §
12 5-303(A) OF THE CODE.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 June 1, 1999.

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
