Chapter 646 of the Acts of 1998

- 2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 3 MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any provision of Chapter 147 of the Acts of the
- 4 General Assembly of 1996, the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, prior to July
- 5 1, [1999] 2000, may not impose any sanctions under that Act, or any regulation
- 6 adopted under it, with respect to an assisted living program, as defined in § 19-801
- 7 <u>19-1801</u> of the Health General Article, that provides services to 15 or fewer
- 8 individuals, unless the actions of an assisted living program that provides services to
- 9 15 or fewer individuals have: (1) caused actual physical or emotional harm to a
- 10 resident in the program; or (2) placed a resident in the program at risk of physical or
- 11 emotional harm.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 June 1, 1999.
