- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any provision of Chapter 147 of the Acts of the
- 16 General Assembly of 1996, the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, prior to July
- 17 1, [1999] 2000, may not impose any sanctions under that Act, or any regulation
- 18 adopted under it, with respect to an assisted living program, as defined in § 19-801 of
- 19 the Health-General Article, that provides services to 15 or fewer individuals, unless
- 20 the actions of an assisted living program that provides services to 15 or fewer
- 21 individuals have: (1) caused actual physical or emotional harm to a resident in the
- 22 program; or (2) placed a resident in the program at risk of physical or emotional
- 23 harm.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 June 1, 1999.
