 FOR the purpose of allowing the local governing body of a municipal corporation to designate certain alternate members of the planning commission of the municipal corporation for certain purposes; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to planning in municipal corporations.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (a) The commission shall consist of either five or seven members, one of whom 17 may be a member of the local legislative body to serve in an ex officio capacity 18 concurrent with his official term. The members shall be appointed by the local 19 legislative body or by such person or persons as the local legislative body creating the 20 commission in the ordinance may designate as the appointing power. Where there is 21 a single local elected executive, the members shall be appointed by the local executive 22 and confirmed by the local legislative body. All members may serve with the 23 compensation the local legislative body deems appropriate. The term of each member	

- 2 **HOUSE BILL 300** 1 is five years or until [his] THE MEMBER'S successor takes office, except that the 2 respective terms of the five members first appointed shall be on a staggered basis. 3 After a public hearing, members may be removed by the local legislative body for 4 inefficiency, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in office. The local legislative body shall 5 file a written statement of reasons for the removal. Vacancies occurring otherwise 6 than through the expiration of term shall be filled for the unexpired term by the local 7 legislative body or by whatever person or persons as the local legislative body creating 8 the commission may designate in the ordinance as the appointing power. 9 The following [counties] LOCAL GOVERNMENTS are excepted from the 10 provisions of subsection (a) to the extent provided in this subsection: 11 (1) In Allegany County, the commission may consist of seven members. 12 The term of each member shall be five years or until his successor takes office, except 13 that the respective terms of the sixth and seventh members first appointed may be 14 less than five years. 15 In Carroll County, the County Commissioners have the discretion to 16 determine whether or not one of the appointive members of the planning and zoning 17 commission is a member of the Board of County Commissioners. The County 18 Commissioners shall designate one alternate member of the commission who may be 19 empowered to sit on the commission in the absence of any member of the commission. 20 When the alternate is absent, the County Commissioners may designate a temporary 21 alternate who shall sit on the commission. 22 (3)The Charles County planning commission is comprised of 7 (i) 23 members and shall represent as many different geographical areas of Charles County 24 as is possible. 25 (ii) Members may receive such compensation as deemed 26 appropriate by the Charles County Commissioners. 27 The members serve for four-year terms or until their successors (iii) 28 are appointed and qualified. The respective terms of the members shall be on a 29 staggered basis.
- 30 (iv) The chairperson shall be appointed annually by the Charles
- 31 County Commissioners.
- 32 A member of the Charles County Commissioners may sit on the
- 33 Charles County planning commission in an ex officio capacity through December 31,
- 34 1988. The member shall have voting privileges on all matters except matters on
- 35 which the member would be called on to vote again in the capacity as a member of the
- 36 Charles County Commissioners, such as zoning and rezoning matters. This member

HOUSE BILL 300

In Cecil County, the planning commission has six regular 1 (4) (i) 2 members and one alternate member. (ii) Members of the planning commission serve for 3-year 3 4 staggered terms. 5 (iii) At the end of a term, an appointed member continues to serve 6 until a successor is appointed and qualifies. 7 An ex officio member serves a term concurrent with the (iv) 8 member's term of office. 9 A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only 10 for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. IN A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODY MAY 12 DESIGNATE ONE ALTERNATE MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION WHO MAY SIT ON THE 13 COMMISSION IN THE ABSENCE OF ANY MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION. WHEN THE 14 ALTERNATE IS ABSENT, THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODY MAY DESIGNATE A 15 TEMPORARY ALTERNATE TO SIT ON THE COMMISSION. 16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
