1 AN ACT concerning	

- 2 Creation of a State Debt Baltimore County Westchester Community
 Center
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- \$120,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the
- 6 Westchester Center Foundation, Inc. for certain acquisition, development, or
- 7 improvement purposes; <u>requiring the grantee to grant and convey a certain</u>
- 8 <u>easement to the Maryland Historical Trust;</u> providing for disbursement of the
- 9 loan proceeds; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds
- 10 evidencing the loan.
- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore
- 15 County Westchester Community Center Loan of 1999 in the total principal amount
- 16 of \$120,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State
- 17 general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and
- 18 issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State
- 19 Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 24 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 25 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then

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- 1 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 2 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 3 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Westchester
- 4 Center Foundation, Inc. for the repair, renovation, and capital equipping of the
- 5 Westchester Community Center, including the installation of air conditioning.
- 6 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 7 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 8 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 9 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 10 (5) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey
- 11 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
- 12 its interest:
- 13 <u>(i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;</u>
- 14 and
- 15 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 16 structures.
- 17 (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
- 18 and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 20 June 1, 1999.
