2 Subject to the hearing provisions of § 19-410 of this subtitle, the Secretary may 3 deny certification as a security guard to any applicant, reprimand any individual 4 certified as a security guard, or suspend [or], revoke, OR REFUSE TO RENEW the 5 certification of an individual:

6 (1) for any applicable ground under § 19-313 of this title;

7 (2) if the applicant or individual fraudulently or deceptively obtains or 8 attempts to obtain certification as a security guard for the applicant or individual or 9 for another; [or]

10 (3) if the applicant or individual fails to maintain the standards set by 11 the Secretary for certification as a security guard; OR

12 (4) IF, UNDER THE LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES OR OF ANY STATE, THE 13 APPLICANT OR INDIVIDUAL PLEADS GUILTY OR NOLO CONTENDERE TO OR IS 14 CONVICTED OF:

15 (I) A FELONY; OR

16 (II) A MISDEMEANOR THAT IS DIRECTLY RELATED TO THE FITNESS
17 AND QUALIFICATION OF THE APPLICANT OR INDIVIDUAL TO BE CERTIFIED AS A
18 SECURITY GUARD.
