EXCEPT FOR THE STUDENT MEMBER, AT LEAST 9 MEMBERS OF THE 1 (2) 2 BOARD SHALL BE RESIDENTS OF THE STATE. 3 Except for the student member, each member serves for a term of 6 (1) 4 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. The terms are staggered as 5 required by the terms of the members serving on July 1, 1978. The student member serves for a term of 1 year and until a successor 6 (2) 7 is appointed and qualifies.
